MS SAVIN is Mississippi's Statewide Automated Victim Information Notification Service.

MS SAVIN is an innovative service providing crime victims, victim advocates, and other concerned citizens free and confidential notification regarding a particular State and/or County inmate's release, transfer or escape from participating agencies.

MS SAVIN can provide registered users access to timely information about offenders 24-hours a day, over the phone, through the Internet, by e-mail, or text messaging.

We advise you not to register a phone number that rings to a switchboard in order to ensure that you receive your notification.

MS SAVIN is a project of the Mississippi Department of Corrections provided by a grant from the US Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance



To access MS SAVINE to check on an inmate's custody status or to register for staus change notifications, please visit the link above.

In addition to checking the status of Mississippi offenders, you may also wish to visit https://www.vinelink.com and click on any state participating in the VINELink program.

Certain agencies may be temporarily off line. Be certain to check which agencies may be temporarily off line.





In order to search for an offender, you will need to locate and click the "Search & Register" tab or locate and click the blue "Offenders" button in the "Search & Register for" box.

Once you click either of these links, you will be presented with a "Disclaimer". Please read this disclaimer before proceeding. This Disclaimer lists information specific to MDOC STATE OFFENDERS. Once you have read and understand the disclaimer, you will need to click the "CONTINUE" button.

At this point, you will be presented with the "Search & Register" tab.

There are two different ways to search for an offender. You may search using the Offender ID number or by conducting a search based on the Offender's Name.

While using an ID is the quickest and most efficient method, you will most likely not know the Offender ID, so we will concentrate on searching by name.

You must know both the Offender's last and first name in order to conduct a search. We also suggest using alternate spellings, middle names, or conducting a partial name search.

To conduct a "Partial last name search", you must click the check box indicating you are conducting a partial search and you **MUST** enter at least the first three letters of the offender's last name.

The "Date of Birth" and "Age Range" fields are optional. However, if known, they will limit the number of records returned.

Once you have entered the information that you have, click the "SEARCH" button.

Remember, you are only searching within the State of Mississippi. To search another state, you must visit https://www.vinelink.com and choose the other state. The format for searching that state should be the same.







Your search results will be appear similar to the ones show to the right.

You may click on an offender's name for details about the offender or to register for updates on change of status.



After clicking on an offender's name, you will see a limited set of details associated with that offender.

The details available include the offender's Date of Birth, Age, Race, Gender, Custody Status, Location of Offender, and in some cases, a Scheduled Release Date and possibly Photo.

At this point, you have the option to "Register for Notification" on an offender's change of status.

You may choose one or all of the methods

After choosing your notification methods, click the "CONTINUE" button

available. Simply select the check the box next to the type of notifications you wish to

receive.

To complete your registration for notification you will need to enter your phone numbers and/or an e-mail address where you want to be contacted.

Phone numbers that ring into a switchboard ARE NOT recommended.

To update an existing registration, you will need your 4-digit PIN and will need to click on this link.


To create a new registration, please follow the instructions on the screen.

Make sure you review all of the information on the VINELink pages as it is subject to change.

- Create and enter a four-digit Personal Identification Number (PIN) that will be used to stop notification calls
- Click the plus sign to register additional phone numbers or e-mail addresses

Once you have entered the required information, click the "REGISTER" button.

Congratulations! You are now registered to receive notification when an offender's custody status or court event changes.
